

Downtown Lodging Shuttle Management

Recommendations from Transportation Solutions

- Discourage all private shuttles (Lodging, Alpine Taxi, etc.) from making stops on or immediately next to Lincoln Avenue, in an organized effort to reduce the impact on overall downtown traffic flow.
- Encourage lodging shuttles to stop only on cross streets for drop-offs and pick-ups, by using alley entrances between Lincoln and Oak / Yampa Streets to pull out of the main flow of traffic.
- Install and number “Lodging Shuttle Zone” signs at various cross-street locations (see below)
 - Downtown “Lodging Shuttle Zone” signage to incorporate similar design standards as the new base area / URA signage. This visual aspect will assist visitors, and will reduce confusion between private lodging shuttles and public SST service. Philo Shelton to coordinate sign installation with Joe Kracum.
- Communicate new procedures to the shuttle community (drivers and riders)
 - Memorandum of procedures and recommendations from Transportation Solutions Group to City Council, City Staff, Private Shuttle Operators, and the Community at Large.
 - Newspaper release
 - Lodging shuttle and Alpine Taxi driver forum
 - Lodging companies to communicate procedures to their guests

Suggested Lodging Shuttle DROP ZONES to be signed

North Side of Lincoln (Oak St)

- 6 North – East Side of 6th Street, by Courthouse Annex (Old Town Pub)
- 7 North – West Side of 7th Street, behind Beau Jo’s
- 8 North – West Side of 8th Street, by the public parking lot
- 9 North – Either or both sides of 9th Street (Azteca / Mr. Money)
- 11 North – East Side of 11th Street , across from Old West Steakhouse / Giovanni’s

South Side of Lincoln (Yampa St)

- 6 South – East Side of 6th Street, by Bank of the West
- 7 South – East Side of 7th Street, by fire hydrant near the Ghost Ranch Saloon and city parking lot
- 8 South – East Side by 8th Street Steakhouse
- 9 South – West Side by Yampa Valley Sound and YVEA
- 10 South – East Side, next to Victoria

Suggested Lodging Shuttle STAGING AREAS

Lodging Shuttle Drop Zones are not to be used for staging vehicles. The drop zones are for loading and unloading only. The following areas have been identified as low-impact staging areas downtown during the evening hours.

North Side of Lincoln Avenue

- Wells Fargo Parking Lot
- 10th Street, near Centennial Hall

South Side of Lincoln Avenue

- Little Toots
- Howelsen Hill
