- \$75 is due with the application, the balance is due September 17, 2009. A payment plan is available but arrangements must be made in advance. If full payment is not received by the agreed upon date, students will be terminated from the course. Checks should be made payable to S.S.C.R.A / Leadership.
- If the student wishes to drop from the course prior to December 15, a portion of the tuition may be refunded.
- Attendance is mandatory at all seminars except the Economic Summit, however, two excused absences will be allowed. Make-up assignments will be required for any unexcused absence. Individual projects must be completed for students to graduate from the course.

- Class will be limited to 20 students and selections will be made by September 7, 2009.
