The 2009 Colorado legislative session saw several bills targeting Pinnacol Assurance. The defeat of one bill—SB273—and the significant modification of a second bill—SB281—was the direct result of Pinnacol supporters contacting their legislators and making their opinions about the bills known.

The focus on Pinnacol has continued this fall as the “Interim Committee Studying Issues Related to Pinnacol” has been meeting. That committee is expected to recommend up to eight bills for consideration when the legislature convenes in January 2010. At that time, Pinnacol will need your help in letting elected officials know your position about those and any other bills that affect Pinnacol or the entire workers' compensation system in Colorado.

Network members will receive regular e-mail alerts about upcoming legislative issues and the Network makes it easy for members to e-mail lawmakers about bills regarding Pinnacol and the workers' compensation system.
