II. Where We've Been

At the last meeting we discussed the downtown shuttle stops as well as parking enforcement. Since then, we have created a report for the large group with recommendations. We will work to prioritize the current issues and define possible solutions

III. Problem/Solution Process

- a. Enhance Mobility
 - i. (West: TIC, Elk River, East: Mountain, Ski Time Square, Central Park: Sundance, YVMC, Downtown)—considering all options
 - ii. Supporting transit that already exists (SST)
- b. Parking Management
 - i. Time Limited Zones could be modified to accommodate demand for longer-term parking
 - ii. Jayson and Philo are working to document the number of spaces downtown, striping options
 - iii. Consider property acquisition for multi-modal/multi-level structure

IV. Problems

- a. Inefficiency within and between the PODS
- b. SST has seen double digit growth, increased costs the past few years while reducing the level of service and expecting a budget reduction
- c. Parking management (capacity, location, time limits)
- d. Bus stop signage
- e. Driver courtesy and traffic enforcement
- f. Education for alternative modes of transportation
- g. Traffic to and from schools to key locations
- h. Funding
