The perfect playground for all ages – Steamboat Springs offers fantastic ways to cool off, serve up and swing away. With perfect summer weather; low humidity, fresh mountain air and ideal temperatures check out these great activities.

The Tennis Center of Steamboat Springs

Play tennis anytime of the year in this new, state-of-the-art tennis facility in Steamboat Springs, Colorado. Located at the base of beautiful Steamboat Ski Area, our indoor and outdoor tennis center offers 6 brand new RSS 500 cushioned-indoor hard courts, 6 outdoor hydrocourt clay courts and 4 outdoor hard courts.

Steamboat Springs Golf Courses

Haymaker Golf Course

This 233 acre, city-owned public golf course was the first course in the state of Colorado to achieve certification through the Audubon International Signature Program. It has been described as a core golf course built for golfers and there is no residential development, no distractions except for the broad vistas of the Yampa Valley and Mount Werner.

Catamount Golf Course

Catamount Ranch & Club is the Yampa Valley's only private golf and lake community. It combines a world class 18-hole Tom Weiskopf championship course with a 532 acre private lake, pristine hay meadows and mountain wilderness. To preserve the character of the landscape for generations to come, they have placed 4,000 acres into the Yampa Valley Land Trust. Catamount has been designated one of Golf Digest's top10 "Best courses" in Colorado and was selected as LINKS magazine's "100 Premier Properties .

Rollingstone Ranch Golf Club (formerly the Steamboat Sheraton Golf Course)

When the Sheraton Steamboat Resort opens its golf course this spring it will have a new name....the Rollingstone Ranch Golf Club, named after the ranch that once bordered Fish Creek. Play the course during the spring run-off and listen to the boulders as they roll down Fish Creek. This season the Robert Trent Jones II championship course, managed by Troon Golf, will have several improvements and will be played as a 17-hole course. Renovations will include: A new entrance – locate off Steamboat Blvd., complete irrigation system remodel, fairway leveling and drainage renovation and an addition and renovation of tees on 11 holes.
